

ADR Center Fellows Program

Each year, in the fall and late spring, the Appropriate Dispute Resolution Center at the University of Oregon looks to recruit and appoint Fellows to support the mission and goals of the Center and to provide opportunities for students to engage in the field of conflict and dispute resolution through the University of Oregon.

Fellowship Overview:

Fellowship appointments are non-stipendiary and require a minimum time commitment of 40 hours per semester.

Fellows will be linked to current or developing programs. Past Fellows have worked on projects including:

- Establishing a pilot probate mediation program in central Oregon
- Researching best practices in truancy prevention through mediation
- Examining individual conflicts in sports and analyzing the impact of the conflict on competitive advantage
- Tracking legislative actions to find bills that impact ADR in Oregon
- Coordinating a joint ADR Center/Environmental and Natural Resources Law interdisciplinary speaker series

This program is open to applications from **all currently-enrolled** University of Oregon students (graduate and undergraduate).
